#### **Deposit**

A \$10 non-refundable deposit is required during the registration process in order to hold your spot for summer camp. The system will not allow you to complete the registration process without payment. This includes families receiving Wisconsin Shares. If you have a credit on your account that you would like to use, please make the payment online and immediately email billing at billingehcsmke.org and let them know that you registered your child but would like to use the credit on your account for your deposit payment.

#### Cancellations

Cancellations received prior to the camp week payment deadline will be honored with no cancellation charge, however, the \$10 deposit is non-refundable.

Cancellations after the payment deadline will be charged 50% of the cost of that week's summer camp, in addition to the \$10 non-refundable deposit.

#### Discounts & Subsidies
